Safeguarding Children - FA Safeguarding children Policy Statement.

The FA recognises its responsibility to safeguard the welfare of all children and young people by protecting them from physical, sexual or emotional harm and from neglect or bullying. The FA is therefore committed to working to provide a safe environment for all children and young people to participate in the sport to the best of their abilities for as long as they choose to do so.

If Parents for any reason cannot take their child to an away match they must ask another Parent / carer of another Team Member but remember the safety of your child is the parent /carers responsibility.

If any parent/ carer lets another team member other than their child travel in their car the child must be in the back seat with a seatbelt on.

It is not the Managers/ Coaches responsibility to arrange Travel to away Matches.
